Samantha Hale Scholarship/Fellowship

The Samantha Hale Scholarship/Fellowship is open to undergraduate students who have completed their sophomore year in the School of Informatics and Computing (SOIC). Students must be in good standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Pre-Requirements:

Experience in at least one of the following areas are sought: digital storytelling, video documentation techniques and editing, 3D modeling, texturing and animation, digital photography, and sound recording and editing.

Requirements:

- Must be an undergraduate student majoring in one of the undergraduate programs in the SOIC
- Must be a student in good standing and have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Must submit required information listed below

Award amounts: \$1,500 available for up to two applicants.

Deadline: February 15th

To apply:

For consideration, applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed student information (below) and Applicant Statement (see pages 2 & 3 of this application).
2. Scholastic Achievement. For the categories listed, you should view each as being “equally weighted” on your application and strive to be as well-rounded as possible.
3. Letter of Recommendation. A minimum of one, but no more than two letters of recommendation from educators and/or employers who are familiar with your background should be sent via email to soicawrd@iupui.edu by the deadline.
