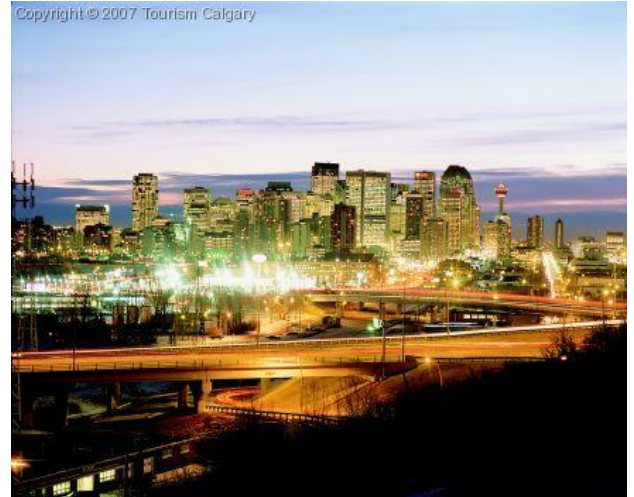


Canada - National Student Exchange Program

PROGRAM DATES

- Program dates will vary depending on university attending.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students will attend one of nine different universities in Canada.
- Participants may take a wide range of courses offered at the chosen university and will maintain full-time status (12 credit hours). Classes will vary depending on college attending.
- Participants will take classes with the general Canadian university student population.

ELIGIBILITY

You may apply if you:

- are a full-time, degree-seeking student at IUPUI and are in good standing.
- have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- Approval to exchange is based on the academic requirements of the student's major program at IUPUI as well as acceptance by the host institution.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- Living arrangements will vary by university.

ESTIMATED 2008-2009 COSTS*

- Since this is an exchange program, students will pay normal IUPUI tuition costs- approximately \$2,612/semester for continuing in-state undergraduates.
- There is a \$75 Study Abroad administrative fee (this fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account.)
- Room and meals will vary depending on the host campus.
- **All students must pay a non-refundable \$150.00 application fee at the time they submit their application for consideration and placement.**

*costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual expenditures.

FINANCIAL AID

- IUPUI scholarships, grants and loans may be applicable to program costs. (Performance scholarships, Guaranteed Tuition certificates, fee courtesies, Indiana Higher Education Awards and awards to children of disabled veterans not applicable.)
