APPROXIMATE DATES

- Summer 2009

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- 3 credit-hours in D546. Students participate in a seven week overview of China prior to the overseas experience.
- Students will visit Beijing to tour the Great Wall and the Forbidden City.



ELIGIBILITY

- The program is open to MBA students, and is not restricted to IUPUI MBA students.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- Students will stay in hotels. Regular bus, train and Underground service give students easy access to most locations.
