## Student teaching in Guangzhou, China

---

### PROGRAM DATES

- Student exchange offered in the fall and spring semester.
- Student teaching placements are for 8 weeks. In the fall these will take place from October-November. In the spring, these will take place from March - April.

### ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Exchange program with Chinese students from Sun Yat-sen University.
- Those placed in Elementary schools will teach English and American Culture.
- Those placed in secondary schools will be teaching in their content area, in English.
- Earn 8 credits hours of student teaching in either Elementary Education (M425) or Middle School Education (M451).



### ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Student must have successfully completed one eight week student teaching placement in Indiana and be eligible for their second placement.
- Chinese language is not required.

*Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.*

### HOUSING

- Students will stay in dorms.

## ESTIMATED 2009 - 2010 COSTS\*

- In-state tuition costs **\$2371**
- International air fare (Indy to Beijing) **\$2000 -approximate**
- Room: **no cost – provided by the Chinese hosts**
- Board: **\$300**
- Visa costs: **\$150**
- Study Abroad Administrative Fee: **\$75** (This fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account.)
- School of Education Administrative Fee: **\$200**
- **Total Estimated Expenses: \$5096 \***

\*costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual spending habits.
