Sociological Study of China at Sun Yat-Sen University in Guangzhou, China

PROGRAM DATES

- **This program will not be running in Summer 2010**
- May 18 – May 22, 2009 –Pre-departure orientation and academic preparation at IUPUI
- May 24- June 15 in China—One week touring in Beijing and two weeks conducting field studies in Guangzhou.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students will work with faculty and students at Sun Yat-Sen University and will conduct an independent study of China on one sociological topic. These include family, the medical system, working organizations, the education system, and community.
- Students will earn 3 credits in Soc R 495. For seniors in Sociology, this course would fulfill the Capstone requirement.



ELIGIBILITY

- Desired cumulative GPA- 2.75.
- Students should have completed R100 Introduction to Sociology and at least one course in Sociology that is related to his/her study topic in China. For non-sociology students, an introductory course and one course relevant to the study topic would be sufficient.
- Students from any IU campus are welcome to participate.
- Chinese language is not required.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- For the first week of the program, students will stay in a hotel close to downtown Beijing. During their two weeks' stay in SYSU, students will be housed in the dormitory for international students located on campus.

ESTIMATED 2009 COSTS*

- In-state tuition costs **\$654**
- International air fare (Indy to Beijing) **\$1,400 -approximate**
- Program Costs and Fees **\$1,430**
This includes air fare within China, touring in Beijing, health insurance, group visa, costs in SYSU, and administrative and program fees.
- Study Abroad Administrative Fee **\$75** (This fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account.)
- **Total Estimated Expenses: \$3,559 + personal expenses***
*costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual expenditures.
