International business in Strasbourg

PROGRAM DATES

- Students will be in France May 30th – June 9th
- Class will run from May 12th – June 23rd

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students must enroll in both D301 International Business and Y350 Politics of the European Union.
- This program consists 5 weeks of instruction at IUPUI and 1 week of instruction and experience in and around Strasbourg, France.

Weeks 1 – 3 consist of classroom instruction in Indianapolis during which students research the European activities of a multinational company located in or near Strasbourg, France.

For week 4 of the program, students will travel to Strasbourg, France. During this week, they will tour the companies being researched, visit some of the European government and cultural institutions that influence the operation of business in that location and hear presentations by EU experts on features of European politics, culture and business.

During week 5 & 6, students will meet again at IUPUI, where they will spend time discussing the application of the study abroad visits to the course material.

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must be in good standing with IUPUI
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Students from other IU campuses are welcome to participate, although priority will be given to IUPUI students enrolled in the Kelley School of Business Indianapolis.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.



ROOM AND BOARD

- Students will stay in a local Strasbourg hotel.
- Meals will primarily be arranged by students.

- Tuition and fees for IUPUI undergraduate students (6 credit hours): \$1845
- Airfare: \$1440
- Hotel costs: \$800
- Transportation (bus rental, metro): \$150
- Cost of train to Paris: \$200
- Meals: \$400
- IUPUI Student Health Insurance: \$26
- IUPUI Study Abroad fee: \$75
- Passport application fee: \$100
- **Total estimated cost: \$5036**
