PROGRAM DATES

- Summer Session. Exact dates arranged according to availability of internship placements.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- 1-2 month internship for Engineering and Technology students.
- Students will receive 1 credit hour in E&T credit.
- Student placements are often in Université de la Méditerranée laboratories but placements may also be arranged with an industry partner.



ELIGIBILITY

- A degree-seeking student in the School of Engineering and Technology at IUPUI.
- Student must have completed sophomore year of degree course work.
- Desired cumulative GPA- 2.75.
- Students with 2 or more courses in college-level French preferred.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- Students will live in university dorms.

ESTIMATED 2008 COSTS*

- **Cost for 2-3 month internship: \$2225-3125 plus 1 credit hour tuition.**
This figure includes the following costs:
- Airline ticket to France (estimate): \$1000*
- Local transportation: \$25-50*
- Housing: \$310-620*
- Meals (estimate): \$450-900*
- Insurance: \$69-93
- Study Abroad Administrative Fee: \$75
- Miscellaneous expenses: \$100-200*

*costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual expenditures.
