French language instruction in Strasbourg at the Universite de Strasbourg

PROGRAM DATES

- July 4 - July 24, 2010

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students will enroll in language and culture courses at Université de Strasbourg during a two week period in July. Upon satisfactory completion of the program, second year students will receive 3 credit hours in F296 (French study abroad) and third year or beyond students will receive 3 credit hours in F396 (French study abroad).
- Second year students have the additional option of taking either F203 or F204 online, offered specially for Strasbourg participants. Upon completion of F203 or F204 online and the summer Strasbourg program, students will receive a total of 6 credit hours.



ELIGIBILITY

- Students enrolled at any Indiana University campus or an Indianapolis Urban Consortium Institution (Butler University, Franklin College, Marian University, University of Indianapolis and Martin University).
- All applicants must have completed first-year French with a "B" average.
- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.75.

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- During their stay in Strasbourg, students will be housed in university dormitories located near campus with access to public transportation to downtown shopping areas. Inexpensive meals at one of the several university student restaurants are served throughout the summer months (program fee does not cover meals).

ESTIMATED 2010 COSTS**

- 3-6 credit hours of tuition: \$654-\$1307 (\$217.70 per credit)
- Program fee: \$950 (Cost includes Universite de Strasbourg fees, room, and transportation for one excursion).
- Study Abroad Administrative Fee: \$75 (This fee will be automatically posted to your bursar account).
- Estimated Airfare: \$1,300
- Passport: \$100
- Travel Insurance: \$26
- Books: \$40
- **Estimated Total: \$3145 - \$3798**

*Meals, personal expenses, optional cultural excursions and events not included in cost.

Costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual expenditures.
