## Spring Break in London

### Exploring Art in London

- Herron School of Art and Design offers this 1 credit-hour course exploring museums, galleries, and historical sites in London, United Kingdom.

### APPROXIMATE DATES

- **This program will not run during Spring Break 2010**
- Program offered on a 3 year rotation

### ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- Students will visit the British Museum, National Gallery, Tate Modern, and other sites including the Institute of Contemporary Art, Westminster Abbey, and Hampton Court.
- Classes will meet each morning with free time to explore in the afternoon.
- Students may choose to use a free day to explore other sites in and around London.



### ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum cumulative GPA- 2.50
- Students from any IUPUI school are eligible to participate. Preference will be given to Herron students.
- Students should have completed at least one 100-level Art History course.

*Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.*

### HOUSING

- Students will stay in hotel/bed and breakfast accommodations. Regular bus, train and Underground service give students easy access to most locations.

## ESTIMATED 2008 COSTS\*

- **\$1,825\* plus 1 credit hour of tuition**
- The following costs are included:
  - Airfare
  - Hotel, double occupancy
  - Insurance
  - Local Transport
  - Study Abroad Administrative Fee (this will be automatically posted to your bursar account.)
  - An additional \$300-\$600\* suggested for personal expenses, souvenirs, and meals.*
- \$500 deposit will be required at time of application. Money will be refunded if not selected for the program.

\*costs will vary depending on the current exchange rate and individual expenditures.  
Tuition fees will be affected by specific student status.
