ELIGIBILITY

- Desired cumulative GPA- 3.0, students with lower GPA's may be considered in exceptional circumstances.
- IUPUI Juniors and Seniors from all majors (this may be waived in exceptional circumstances) and graduate students in History, Public History, and Museum Studies.
- Newcastle University must have courses that will fulfill IUPUI degree requirements (major, minor, electives).

Complete eligibility criteria and selection criteria are outlined within the Academic Policies and Procedures of the Office of Study Abroad. Selection is based on maturity, seriousness of purpose, and appropriateness of match between program and applicant. Students on academic or disciplinary probation during program period are not eligible. Students must be at least 18 years old to participate on an IUPUI Study Abroad Program.

HOUSING

- Students will live in university dorm accommodations located approximately 10 minutes by foot from the campus and city center. Regular buses link the dorms to the main campus and to the city center.
