

How to Apply for the Strasbourg, France International Business Program

This program requires the following:

- Complete the online application.

- Complete the Agreement and Release Form. *Please read this form carefully.*

- Two letters of recommendation from a faculty member/college instructor, which includes phone number of reference. IUPUI faculty preferred.
- \$500 deposit- Due by December 11, 2009, to be turned in to Jaime Clougher in BS 3024. This is not an application fee. Deposit will be returned in the event that you are not selected for the program. Once selected for the program, the deposit becomes non-refundable. Please make the check out to Indiana University.
- A short (1-2 page) well-written personal statement that addresses the following:
 - Why are you applying for this program?
 - This program is on an accelerated summer I schedule. What are your time commitments during this period and how do you plan to adjust to this schedule?
 - What is your interest in international business in general, and in the host country in particular?
 - Life in another country involves significantly different living situations, academic environments and social customs. What experience and skills do you have that will help you cope with such differences?

 - What do you expect to be the most challenging aspects of this program?
 - What are your primary extra-curricular activities and interests?

 - Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?
 - Is there anything about your academic record or information in your application that you would like to explain further?

- You need to complete the form below if you are an Indiana University student who does not attend IUPUI. This includes students enrolled in an Indiana University school at IPFW. <http://abroad.iupui.edu/forms/homeschoolagreement2.pdf>
- You need to complete the form below if you are a student from outside the Indiana University system. This includes students enrolled in a Purdue University school at IPFW, but not Purdue students at IUPUI. <http://abroad.iupui.edu/forms/homeschoolagreement1.pdf>
- All students not in the Indiana University system need to submit an official transcript from their college/university. This includes students enrolled in a Purdue University school at IPFW, but not Purdue students at IUPUI.
- Students who transferred to IUPUI from a non-IU campus and do not currently have a GPA at IUPUI need to include an official transcript from the university/college they transferred from.
